In March 2001 when the BBC closed it's Resources department at Pebble Mill Birmingham I became a Freelance Lighting Electrician.

I have travelled across the world for the BBC and have a vast experience of overseas power systems.

In 1982 I had leave of absence from the BBC to go to India to help make a film to publicise the tragedy of Blinding Malnutrition in infants. This film, "A for Eyesight", was translated into many languages, distributed world wide and made thousands of pounds for the Royal Commonwealth Society for the Blind Sight Savers fund. In addition to lighting I did supplementary sound recording. The film was recognised with a highly commended award in 1983.
